

Tools Needed

The following lists catalog tools needed. These items are to be prepositioned at the warehouse and sent to established worksites then returned to the warehouse when the worksite is shutdown at the end of a response. Please consider purchasing one or more of the following items for the warehouse or giving a direct financial gift to facilitate the purchase.

- Cordless power tools Sawzalls, drills/screw guns
- Air powered framing, finishing and roofing tools
- Power sanders, hand sanding blocks
- Hammers claw hammers and sledge hammers
- Crow bars, nail pullers, pry bars, wonder bars
- Flat shovels, round shovels, corn-scoop shovels
- Sandpaper assorted grades
- Sheetrock finishing screens and handles
- Utility knives and blades
- Tape measures, straight-edges, sheet rock squares
- Dehumidifiers
- Moisture meters
- Flood lights on stands and replacement bulbs
- Folding saw horses
- Circular saws and extra blades
- Miter saws
- Jig saws
- Table Saws
- Mechanics tools of all kinds
- Air powered framing nailers and roofing nailers
- Extension cords
- Ground fault protectors for extension cords
- Drywall lifts (for hanging ceilings.)
- Chalk lines and chalk
- Drywall squares
- Drywall finishing tools
- Drywall mud troughs
- Drywall hand saws—various styles ok
- Pump style garden sprayers (for spraying bleach and mold abatement agents)
- Work gloves in quantity, leather palm, rubber gloves, heavy duty latex gloves, cotton gloves

- Push brooms and heavy duty regular brooms
- Heavy duty Brute style trash cans
- Contractor trash bags—heavy duty only
- High quality respirators for protection from mold N95 3M style
- Paint brushes, paint roller frames and covers, extension poles and paint pans, paint screens
- Masking tape, duck tape
- Flashlights
- Batteries, all types
- Gas cans, plastic and steel safety cans
- Portable contractor style kerosene powered salamander heaters / kerosene fuel cans

THINGS THAT ARE NOT NEEDED AND NOT ACCEPTED:

- Clothing
- Food items, except MREs

MOLD REMEDIATION AND ABATEMENT CHEMICALS

- Concrobium (preferred) by the case load <u>Concrobium</u>
- Bleach by the case load

 Home Depot or Lowes gift cards for use by site managers to buy what they need as needed.

Collection and Delivery Instructions

- Items should be delivered in person or shipped to the MNA Warehouse in Rome Georgia.
- Notify us in advance of your collection campaign as needs change daily.
- Once your collection efforts are complete and before departure for the MNA Warehouse, please prepare an abstract list of your collection and send to us electronically at mnawarehouse@pcanet.org so that we know what you will be bringing and therefore coordinate your arrival. This is important so that we can plan accordingly. Be prepared to let us know the exact day and time of arrival so that we can coordinate delivery.
- Mid-size U-Haul or Rider type trucks, pickup trucks, flat bed and enclosed trailers work best for deliveries. Tractor-trailers are also okay; a loading dock, fork truck and pallet jacks are on site.
- Volunteers should accompany the delivery of the equipment and supplies to help unload once arriving at the MNA Warehouse.
- If you anticipate needing overnight accommodations while you are making a delivery at the MNA Warehouse in Rome, Georgia please notify us in advance; we may be able to arrange lodging. Please know that housing may be limited and a morning delivery may work best so you can get back out the same day if at all possible, especially in times of new disaster responses.
